Eagle Zone begins at 6:15 AM. The morning session goes until the start of school at each elementary school site. The afternoon session starts at the end of the school day for each site and goes until 6:00 PM, when Eagle Zone ends.

Summer programming will be available beginning in June 2019. More information regarding summer programming will be released at the beginning of the 2018-2019 school year.

Eagle Zone will be based out of your school's cafeteria, but we will utilize space throughout the elementary school, including the gym, playground, art room, and classrooms.



Eagle Zone will take your child on amazing field trips throughout the metro area on non-school days and throughout the summer. The trips are a great opportunity to go on new adventures and learn something new!

REGISTRATION DETAILS

Before School Session	\$11.75/day	Registration opens March 15th.
After School Session	\$11.75/day	Registration opens March 15th.
Drop-in Care	\$14.00/day	Must request drop-in care at least 3 business days in advance.
Non-School Days (Prior to Deadline)	\$41.00/day	Registration is due 10 business days prior to program date.
Non-School Days (After Deadline)	\$51.00/day	Registrations within 10 business days will be charged a \$10 late fee.

**An annual \$50 per child registration fee is due along with your registration.*

Financial Assistance
We will work with Hennepin County Childcare Assistance to provide financial support to qualified families.

Choosing a Schedule

Families must register for a minimum of one session per week. A session is considered to be either before or after school care on one day. Schedules must be consistent from week-to-week, but families can add drop-in days as needed or submit a permanent schedule change. We will ask families to provide us with ten business days notice for a schedule change to allow for staff to student ratio compliance.

Billing

Billing is done monthly. Invoices will be sent out around the 15th of each month for the care that is scheduled to be provided during the following month. Payments are due on the 1st of the month.

September bills will be sent out around the 15th of August. Payment is due September 1st. That covers care that will be provided by Eagle Zone in the month of September.

NON-SCHOOL DAYS

Program participants are asked to bring various items to non-school days. Please make sure that all items are labeled with the name of the child bringing the item. For all non-school days, children should bring:

- Lunch and beverage
- Morning and afternoon snack (a morning and afternoon snack will be provided by Eagle Zone, but children wishing to have an additional morning/afternoon snack should bring one with them)
- Swimsuit and towel on field trip days that include swimming
- Appropriate clothing for outdoor play
- Appropriate clothing for arts and crafts

Field Trips

Costs of activities and field trips are included in the registration fee. Transportation will be provided by the Eden Prairie Schools Transportation Department, or a designated charter company, according to school district policy. Eagle Zone t-shirts must be worn for field trip days. A t-shirt is included with registration; additional t-shirts can be purchased on-site.

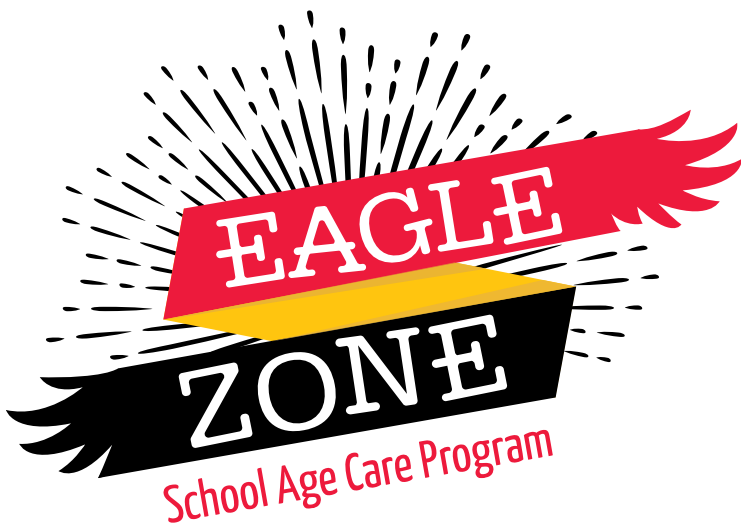

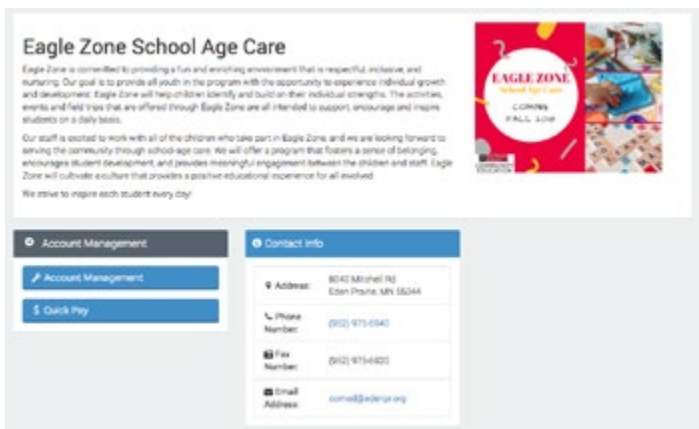
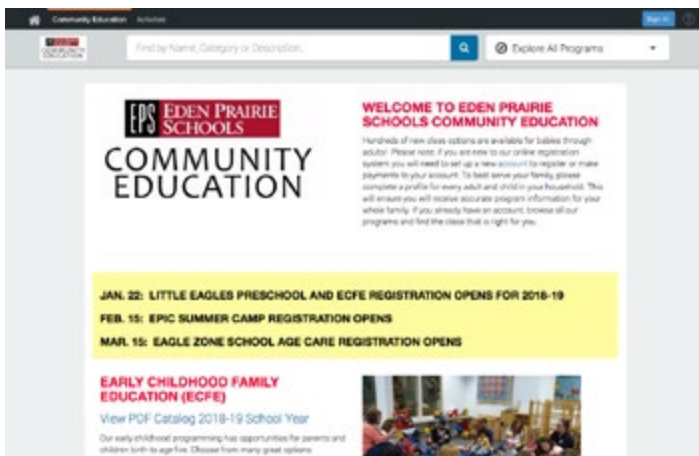

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EAGLE ZONE: WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

WILL THERE BE BREAKFAST AVAILABLE FOR MY CHILD?

Breakfast is available from the school's food service program every day school is in session. Students participating will use their school lunch account to purchase breakfast.

WILL THERE BE A SNACK PROVIDED FOR MY CHILD?

Students are encouraged to bring healthy snacks from home before school. Eagle Zone will provide an afternoon snack.

HOW MANY SESSIONS DOES MY CHILD NEED TO ATTEND?

Students must register for at least one session a week to be enrolled in Eagle Zone. The schedule must remain consistent on a weekly basis to ensure staffing needs are met and we can offer a high quality program.

HOW DOES CHECK-IN AND CHECK-OUT WORK?

Parents/guardians must sign their child in to the program for the before school session. You must also sign-out your child when picking them up during the after school session. You are also required to provide permission for anyone other than a parent/guardian to pick up your child. When you register for Eagle Zone on Eleyo, you will be asked to name persons authorized to pick-up your child. You can add authorized individuals for pick-up on Eleyo as you need.

HOW DOES REGISTRATION WORK?
