C.O.R.E. Time

Centered On Reaching Each Thursdays after 1st Period

C.O.R.E. is a designated time in our school week to provide each student with an additional opportunity to achieve success in school. This 45-minute block of time during the school day provides the flexibility that students need to meet with teachers, to make up missed work, to study for an upcoming test, to work on a class project, to complete homework, or to engage in various enrichment activities.

During C.O.R.E. time, students have three options:

- 1. Teacher or other staff will assign students to work with a teacher to receive help with their academic work or to make up a test or quiz. If assigned, students are expected to attend.
- 2. Sign-up to see a teacher for support.
- 3. Sign-up for quiet study spaces or work independently or in small groups in our Commons spaces.

Notification:

- 1. Students use our C.O.R.E. website www.core.edenpr.org and login using their student ID and their lunch pin number + "learn" to access or check their Thursday C.O.R.E. assignment.
- 2. Parents and students are notified via email on Wednesday evening if students have been assigned by a teacher to a C.O.R.E. session.

Attendance:

1. The same expectations as for regular classes apply. The same processes for absences will be followed.
