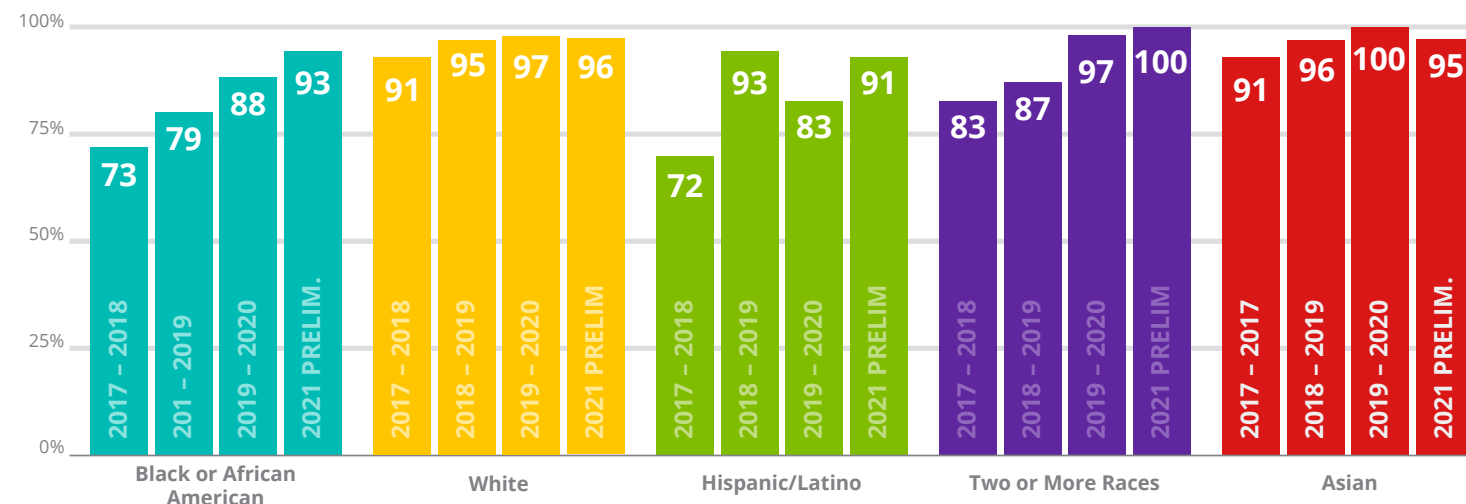

Eden Prairie Schools' increasing graduation rates show the district delivering strong academic achievement for all, and narrowing gaps in historical educational disparities. The district's four-year graduation rate overall is 95 percent.

Thank you for being a part of Eden Prairie Schools. With your on-going support we are staying true to our mission of inspiring each student every day.

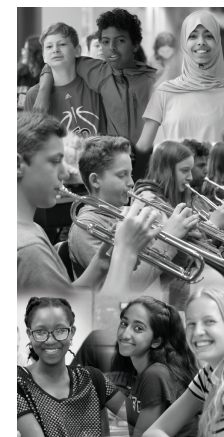
