



- How does inflation impact the levy amount and the cap?
- 0 Both numbers move with the Consumer Price Index for Urban Consumers (CPI-U)
- Market basket of consumer goods and services
- February 2022 7.9% over 12 months



- How do we envision inflation impacting the 5-year forecast?
- We do see inflationary pressure on short term wages, energy, and food as prices increase and purchasing power erodes
- 0 The 5-Year forecast builds in inflation on an annual basis
