

PASS / NO CREDIT APPLICATION and GUIDELINES

Deadlines for turning in the Pass / No Credit Application:

Term 1 : October 16th, 2019

Term 2: December 18th, 2019

Term 3: March 4th, 2020

Term 4: May 13th, 2020

The purpose of the Pass or No Credit option is to allow students an opportunity to take courses and not have the final grade impact their GPA.

- The P / NC option may be used for any course **once** in a term and only **two** times per year
- Neither the Pass or No Credit carries any weight to your GPA
 - **Pass (P) = earning 60% and above will receive a credit**
 - **No Credit (NC) = earning 59% or lower will not receive a credit.**
- Students who earn a grade of "A" for the term will receive the "A" grade instead of the "P." The "A" is computed into the GPA.
- The grades of "A-" and below will not be recorded as a grade but as a "P".
- The student must continue to meet all classroom expectations after choosing the P/NC option or the option will be revoked and the student will be graded on an "A – F" scale. This includes completion of daily work, projects and quizzes/tests. Class attendance is mandatory.
- It is recommended that students who plan to attend college, not use the P/NC option in academic core classes (English, Social, Math, Science, World Languages). When in doubt, students should consult the college of interest.
