

Budget Factors - Largest Drivers

• Revenue:

 Enrollment, basic formula allowance, tax levy, special education aid, voter approved levies

• Expenditures:

 Enrollment, salary/benefits, class size ratios, medical insurance rates, property insurance rates, workers compensation, utility rates, inflation impact

General Education Aid


- Largest source of revenue for the district
- State funds used for any operating expense
- Formula Allowance <u>times</u> Adjusted Pupil Units (\$6,863 x 9,818)
 - FY23 = \$67.4 million

- Adjusted Pupil Unit (APU)
 - Total Enrollment = Resident + Open Enrollment + EPO
 - 1.0 weighting Grades K-6
 - 1.2 weighting Grades 7-12
 - Preschool is Largely Parent Funded

Legislative Impact - Gen Ed Aid

• AMSD:

- Increase formula 5%, index to inflation
- Governor:
 - Increase formula 4%,
 - Index to inflation (CPI-U, no less than 0%, no more than 3%), starting in FY26

Financial Impact of Governor's proposal for EPS:

- Formula = \$2.5 million in FY24
- Indexed = Variable, 10 year average = \$1.8 million

Voter Approved Levies & Tax Levy

- 2 Voter Approved Levies
 - Operating Referendum expires June 30, 2033
 - Capital Project Levy expires June 30, 2035
- Annual Tax Levy
 - Board approved in December



Expenditure Categories - % Spent




- Budget Assumptions
 - Presented annually in January and March
 - Establishes the budget framework
 - Addresses enrollment, class size, insurance, purchased services, department/building budgets, utilities, etc
- Annual Budget
 - 1st Draft in May
 - Approval in June (Required by law)

- Definition The unfunded cost of special education programs for students with disabilities.
 - Revenue includes State, Federal, 3rd Party Billing, and General Education Aid that reasonably follows the student)
 - General Fund pays the subsidized portion

Legislative Impact - SpEd Cross Subsidy

- AMSD:
 - Fully Fund, eliminate the cross subsidy
- Governor:
 - Increasing the cross-subsidy aid reduction from 6.43% to 47.30% in FY24

Financial Impact of Governor's proposal for EPS:

- Based on the variable expenses in the previous slide:
 - \$2.3 million \$3.8 million annually



Fund Balance (District Policy 714)

- Non-spendable not in spendable form or legal requirement
 - Prepaid items, Inventories
- <u>Committed</u> used for specific purpose by formal board action
- Restricted legally enforceable constraints
 - Operating capital, health & safety, basic skills, staff development
- Assigned district's intent for specific purpose
 - Capital, site carryover
- <u>Unassigned</u> for all other purposes not described by other categories
 - Used to calculate Statutory Operating Debt (SOD)
 - Used to calculate compliance with board policy
 - The fund balance mostly widely referred to by individuals



Why Have a Fund Balance?

- Necessary for unknown situations:
 - Irregular payments of state and local revenues
 - State aid proration, metering of payments, tax shift, state shut down
 - Mandated but not funded programs
 - Higher utility costs
 - Greater than expected inflation
 - Changes in enrollment and state funding
 - Pandemics!
- Sound fiscal management has a long term positive impact on the success of students
- Validates fiscal credibility with various reporting constituencies, including establishing a good credit rating
- Minimum of 8% per School Board Policy

Policy Type: Governance Process Policy Title: 4.4 Officer Roles

Officers of the School Board are empowered with specific responsibilities delegated to them by the School Board or by state statute. Officers are elected following nominations during the first meeting in January. The following outlines their responsibilities.

- 4.4.1 The Chair is empowered by the School Board to assure the integrity of the School Board's governing process as well as the adherence to rules legitimately imposed on it from outside the district. The Chair resides over each meeting and is expected to:
 - 4.4.1.1 Conduct a meeting that follows the governance protocol, processes and procedures agreed upon by the School Board.
 - 4.4.1.2 Maintain a School Board meeting atmosphere that is respectful, engaging and productive.
 - 4.4.1.3 Assure all required School Board actions brought forward, including Superintendent consent agenda items are handled expeditiously.

Additional responsibilities include, but may not be limited to:

- 4.4.1.4 Developing meeting agendas in concert with the Vice Chair and Superintendent that are consistent with the School Board's Annual work plan and School Board-approved agenda procedures. The Board Chair may include a third Board Member on a rotating basis for Board Development purposes.
- 4.4.1.5 Responding on behalf of the School Board to all external email communications from owners.
- 4.4.1.6 Representing the School Board to external organizations as required.
- 4.4.1.7 Representing the School Board's stated position on topics in newspaper, media and other email communications when requested.
- 4.4.1.8 Delegating authority if necessary but maintaining accountability for its use.
- 4.4.1.9 Appointing School Board members to School Board committees, requested Admin committees, and external organization positions requiring School Board involvement.

- 4.4.2 The Vice-Chair will serve in the absence of the Chair, assist the Chair as requested in the execution of Chair responsibilities, co-develop meeting agendas consistent with the School Board's Annual Work Plan with the Chair and Superintendent, and act as the School Board parliamentarian.
- *** ***4.4.3 The Treasurer reviews School Board expenses on a monthly basis and reports School Board expenses vs. the budget set in Governance Process policy 4.9 at mid-year and year-end. In addition, the Treasurer reviews the Superintendent's expenses at mid-year and year-end and conducts and reports on the Superintendent contract review annually.
 - 4.4.4 The Clerk approves the final draft of School Board meeting minutes and workshop topic summaries prior to School Board approval. The Clerk will read all formal resolutions to be voted on by the School Board. The Clerk will also assure the School Board's policies are accurately recorded, maintained and posted.

Policy Title: 2.6 Financial Management and Operations

The Superintendent shall not cause or allow the development of financial jeopardy or a material deviation of actual expenditures from the current budget without School Board approval. Furthermore, the Superintendent shall not:

- 2.6.1 Allow payroll or debts to be settled in an untimely manner.
- 2.6.2 Allow payments or other government-ordered payments or filings to be overdue or inaccurately filed.
- 2.6.3 Use contingency funds greater than \$100,000 without informing the School Board.
- 2.6.4 Acquire, encumber, or dispose of real property without School Board approval.
- 2.6.5 Lease real property or remodel leased real property without School Board approval.
- 2.6.6 Allow receivables to remain unpursued after a reasonable grace period.
- **2.6.7 Allow fee-based relationships in excess of \$100,000 annually to continue beyond 3 years without a formal review that includes an analysis of contract fees and performance.

Measuring What Matters

Third Grade Reading Metrics

2021-2022 School Year Academic Achievement

<u>Introduction</u>

The Eden Prairie School Board formally reviews third grade reading metrics each year when Ends Policy 1.2 is monitored. This policy states: "Each student is reading at grade level by the end of third grade." During the monitoring process the Superintendent must provide evidence that the district is making reasonable progress toward this goal.


Studies show that in third grade students transition from learning to read to reading to learn. If students are not reading at grade level in third grade it can negatively impact their academic achievement in future years, so the Board prioritizes this goal in its policies.

Sound research and measurement practices involve the triangulation of data for each student to identify success. Eden Prairie Schools utilize three reading assessments to measure proficiency and provide comprehensive evidence that third grade students are reading at grade level.

<u>Data</u>

The data for the 2021-2022 school year was presented to the Board on October 24, 2022.

Target Set for 2021-2022: 80%: Level of Achievement: 78%



School Board's Perspective on the Data

On October 24, 2022, the School Board monitored Ends Policy 1.2. The Superintendent asserted that reasonable progress had not been made, falling just short of the 80% target.

The School Board debated this assertion extensively, evaluating: (1) Management did not reach the target, (2) Management initially proposed a 78% metric, but the board requested (and management agreed) to raise performance expectations to 80%, (3) Although EP Schools maximized in person school days during the 2021-2022 school year, there were significant COVID distractions and student/staff absences that impacted student learning, (4) The 80% target was set during the summer of 2021, before additional COVID restrictions/impacts were contemplated, (5) FastBridge test results (which are last in the evaluation cycle) were trending towards the 80% metric, (6) Supplemental initiatives to improve reading performance, including the "Power Reading" program, gained traction post MCA/MTAS testing, (7) EP School reading outcomes vs surrounding school districts demonstrated superior execution and performance.

Considering the aforementioned factors in 2021-2022, and the improving data trends seen in the recent test metrics, the School Board decided not to accept the Superintendent's assertion and concluded that reasonable progress had been made by the school district. Although the School Board considered extraordinary circumstances for the 2021-2022 measurement period, the School Board reasserted the reading proficiency target for 2022-2023 at 80%, reflecting the expectation that the district consistently raises performance expectations for each child in our district.
