EPIC YOUTH SUMMER CAMPS

FOR TARGETED SERVICES REFERRED STUDENTS

Your child has been referred for Targeted Services by their classroom teacher. Targeted Services is a program funded by the State of Minnesota which allows your student to attend select EPIC Summer camps for FREE. The camps that qualify are listed on the following pages. Participation is optional and at the discretion of parents. In addition, your student is offered free transportation to and from the Targeted Services camps which are only offered in the morning, 9:00 AM–12:00 PM. *All students who qualify for Targeted Services must be enrolled in camps by May 18th to receive bus transportation.*

Camps offered through Targeted Services are taught by licensed teachers and designed to support academic and social skills in a supportive and fun atmosphere. Our camps cover a wide variety of topic areas and align with district academic standards. The curriculum is intentionally designed to meet each student's academic needs, encompassed in an engaging theme. Student choice is an important aspect of engaged learning, and students are encouraged to select the camps that interest them. To keep your child's mind active all summer long, we recommend signing up for at least four camps.

MORNING CAMPS

8:00–8:45 AM	Drop Off
9:00 AM–12:00 PM	Morning Camp
12:00–12:30 PM	Pick Up

12:00–1:00 PM Supervised Lunch
Available for children attending both morning and afternoon camps. Please pack a lunch and drink.

AFTERNOON CAMPS

12:30–1:00 PM	Drop Off
1:00–4:00 PM	Afternoon Camp
4:00–5:00 PM	Pick Up

All children who qualify for summer Targeted Services and require transportation, MUST sign up before May 18th.

What you need to know about **TARGETED SERVICES**

How do I know if my child was referred?

Students are referred by their classroom teacher. If you have questions about your child's referral, please contact their teacher.

How do I register for classes?

First, your child's teacher will provide a Continuous Learning Plan. This outlines the academic goals and focus areas for each student. Second, you must return a signed copy of the Continuous Learning Plan to your child's teacher. Then, you may register for selected morning camps at no cost. This can be done online, at www.edenpr.org/EPIC; by phone at 952-975-6940; or in person at the Education Center, at 8040 Mitchell Road.

What does it cost?

Referred students are invited to attend the selected morning camps at no cost. You are welcome to also register for afternoon camps, which start at \$99.

How many sessions does my child need to attend?

It's completely your choice. We recommend that students who qualify for Targeted Services enroll in at least four weeks of camps. This allows us adequate time with each student to continue to develop their academic skills and confidence.

Is transportation available?

Students qualified for Targeted Services are eligible for free bus transportation to and from morning camps. To receive transportation, students must be currently enrolled in Eden Prairie Schools, live within the district boundary, and be registered by May 18.

Can a sibling not in a Targeted Services Camp take the Targeted Services bus?

Yes. Siblings of students referred for Targeted Services are invited to ride the Targeted Services bus to and from morning EPIC Summer Camps. To receive transportation, siblings must have completed kindergarten, be currently enrolled in Eden Prairie Schools, live within the district boundary and be registered by May 18.

When do I drop off and pick up?

If your child is not riding the bus, they will need to be signed in and out every day by a parent/guardian at Oak Point/Eagle Heights Cafeteria. Students attending morning-only camps must be signed in by 8:45 AM, and must be picked up by 12:30 PM.

How does check-in and check-out work?

Children will be released to authorized persons only or escorted to their Targeted Services bus. If a child is to be picked up by anyone other than the legal guardian, written notification must be given to EPIC staff or emailed to EPIC@edenpr.org. Please include multiple emergency contacts when registering.

Need financial assistance for afternoon camps?

Are you interested in staying for afternoon camps but need financial assistance? We offer scholarships to families for all Community Education camps and classes. Visit www.edenpr.org/feeassistance to learn more.

What if my child is not referred - can they still attend camps at EPIC?

All students are welcome to attend EPIC. If you are not a referred student there is a fee attached to each camp. We offer financial assistance to families who qualify.


How Does Targeted Services Registration Work?

1. Receive referral to Targeted Services from your classroom teacher.
2. Sign the Continuous Learning Plan provided by your classroom teacher.
3. Register for the camps of you and your student's choice at www.edenpr.org/epcommunityed, call 952-975-6940, or visit us at the Education Center.


Registering online is quick and easy! We have one convenient place to register for all Community Education programs from early childhood through adult classes. If you haven't already done so, create an account to register yourself and your family members for a class or activity.

When registering for Targeted Services camps, select the \$0.00 camp fee option.



After selecting the camp, you will be asked a few short questions about the Targeted Services referral. This information is needed for reporting to the State of Minnesota.
