Our EPIC youth program ignites interest and challenges youth in a fun, safe, and supportive atmosphere. Enrichment and recreational classes are available to students before and after school and throughout the summer for youth ages four and up!

Targeted Services

EPIC also includes Targeted Services. Targeted Services is a state-funded program designed to create programming that ensures each student reaches their academic goals. Students are referred by their classroom teacher.

Targeted Services qualified students are eligible for free bus transportation to and from morning camps for the first seven weeks of EPIC. Registrations MUST be received by May 18 to receive transportation.

EPIC Summer Camps FAQs

WELCOME TO EPIC SUMMER CAMPS

Eden Prairie Schools Community Education is proud to offer EPIC Summer Camps, a youth program designed to be flexible, affordable, and full of fun!

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

Registrations are due one week before the camp starts.

DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP

All students need to be signed in and out every day by a parent/guardian between 8:00–8:45 AM and 4:00–5:00 PM at Oak Point/Eagle Heights Cafeteria. Students attending morning-only camps must be picked up by 12:30 PM. Drop-off for students attending afternoon-only camps begins at 12:30 PM. Please enter and exit the building through the Lower Parking Lot.

CHECK-IN AND CHECK-OUT

Children will be released to authorized persons only or escorted to their Targeted Services bus. If a child is to be picked up by anyone other than their legal guardian, written notification must be sent to EPIC@edenpr.org, or provided to EPIC staff. Please include multiple emergency contacts when registering.

LATE PICK-UP FEES

EPIC closes at 5:00 p.m. each day. A late fee of \$1 per minute will be assessed for any child picked up after 5:00 PM.

LUNCH AND SNACKS

If your child is staying all day, they will need to bring a lunch and drink. We will store all lunches in the refrigerator. We also suggest that your child brings a snack and a water bottle for each camp they are attending. Please be aware that there may be occasions where you are asked to bring non-peanut items due to allergies within the group.

SUNSCREEN

Please apply sunscreen prior to your child attending camp. All EPIC camps go outside at least once for a break. You are welcome to send sunscreen with your child if they are staying all day. EPIC staff will supervise the application of sunscreen, but cannot help your child apply sunscreen. We will assist in helping students apply sunscreen to their upper back if requested, and will encourage reapplication of sunscreen throughout the day.

SUPERVISED DURING NON-CAMP CARE TIMES

EPIC staff will supervise drop-off, lunch, and pick-up time periods outside the regular camp times at no cost to you. During these times, students have the option to participate in activities until their parents arrive, or the next camp begins.

WEATHER POLICY

All camps have rain backups in place, so schedules will run as normal.

EPIC STAFF

Our EPIC staff are dedicated professionals whose primary focus is providing a safe, fun, and enriching experience for your child. All classes offered through Targeted Services are taught by a licensed teacher. All other classes are taught either by district-employed Youth Programs staff or by contracted instructors.

STAFF RATIOS

EPIC staff will follow state guidelines for out-of-school time student-to-teacher ratios, which are 15 to 1. Camps for 4-year-olds follow a 10 to 1 ratio.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Fee assistance is available for qualified families. Visit www.edenpr.org/feeassistance for more information.

GRADES

Grades listed are entering grades for the 2020-2021 school year. Pre-K students must be age 4 by the first day of camp.

CAMP LOCATION

All camps are hosted at Oak Point Elementary / Eagle Heights Spanish Immersion, located at 13400 Staring Lake Parkway. Please enter the building through the Lower Parking Lot.

BUS TRANSPORTATION

Students who qualify to attend classes through Targeted Services are eligible for free bus transportation to and from morning camps.

REFUND POLICY

If you need to cancel, please notify us at 952-975-6940, or EPIC@edenpr.org, and we will refund your camp fee minus a \$5 processing fee. No refunds can be given on or after the start of camp.

DOES YOUR FAMILY NEED CHILD CARE ON FRIDAYS OR BEFORE AND AFTER YOUR EPIC CAMPS?

Eden Prairie Schools Community Education's Eagle Zone program has options to fit your family's needs. Eagle Zone is designed as a 'pick-your-days' program to allow families to choose a schedule that works for them. Register for EPIC and Eagle Zone separately and select the desired options during the Eagle Zone registration process.

Eagle Zone Half Day Option

If you are enrolled in a morning EPIC camp and need afternoon care at Eagle Zone, or need morning Eagle Zone care before an afternoon EPIC camp, the daily rate will be \$29 per child. This rate will be presented as an option during the registration process for Eagle Zone. Families must register seven calendar days before the date they wish to receive care.

Eagle Zone Early Morning or Late Afternoon Option

If you only need care before or after EPIC, that is available with a daily rate of \$12 per child. This rate applies to families who need care early in the morning prior to attending EPIC or late afternoon care after attending EPIC, and it can be combined with the half day options. Families must register seven calendar days before the date they wish to receive care.

If you need care all day on Friday, the Eagle Zone Full-Day daily rate is \$49/child, unless the day is requested within seven calendar days, then it is \$55/child.

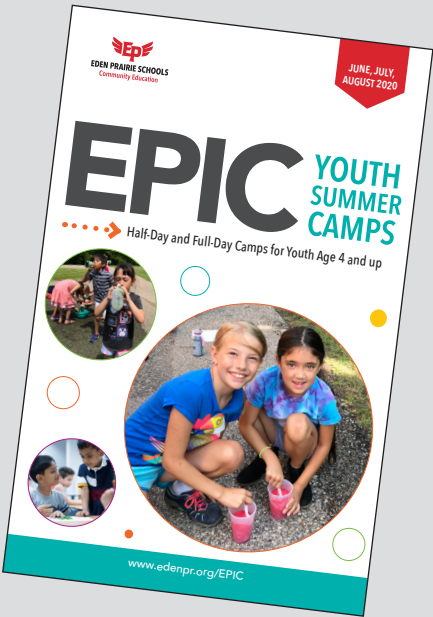

What you need to know about

•••➤ TARGETED SERVICES

Students entering Grades 1-6 who have qualified can attend select camps for FREE this summer based on classroom teacher recommendations through a program called Targeted Services, funded by the State of Minnesota. These classes are identified with a ✨. Participation is optional and at the discretion of parents.

Camps offered through Targeted Services are taught by licensed teachers and designed to support academic and social skills in a supportive and fun atmosphere. Our camps cover a wide variety of topic areas and align with district academic standards. Though it may sound on the surface like just a fun camp, the curriculum is intentionally designed to meet each student's academic needs, encompassed in an engaging theme. Student choice is an important aspect of engaged learning, and students are encouraged to select the camps that interest them.

Our goal is to provide a program that enhances student engagement, creates meaningful experiences and supports the academic goals for each student. To keep your child's mind active all summer long, we recommend signing up for at least four camps.

How do I know if my child was referred?

Students are referred by their classroom teacher. Before registering, you will need to receive and sign a Continuous Learning Plan, which will be shared by your child's teacher. If you have questions about your child's referral, please contact their teacher.

What does it cost?

Referred students are invited to attend the selected morning camps at no cost. You are welcome to also register for afternoon camps, which start at \$99.

How many sessions does my child need to attend?

It's completely your choice. We recommend that students who qualify for Targeted Services enroll in at least four weeks of camps. This allows us adequate time with each student to continue to develop their academic skills and confidence.

Is transportation available?

Students qualified for Targeted Services are eligible for free bus transportation to and from morning camps. To receive transportation, students must be currently enrolled in Eden Prairie Schools and be registered by May 18, 2020.

Can a sibling not in a Targeted Services Camp take the Targeted Services bus?

Yes. Siblings of students referred for Targeted Services are invited to ride the Targeted Services bus to and from morning EPIC Summer Camps. To receive transportation, siblings must have completed kindergarten, be currently enrolled in Eden Prairie Schools, and be registered by May 18.

When do I drop off and pick up?

If your child is not riding the bus, they will need to be signed in and out every day by a parent/guardian at Oak Point/Eagle Heights Cafeteria. Students attending morning-only camps must be signed in by 8:45 a.m., and must be picked up by 12:30 PM.

How does check-in and check-out work?

Children will be released to authorized persons only or escorted to their Targeted Services bus. If a child is to be picked up by anyone other than the legal guardian, written notification must be given to EPIC staff or emailed to EPIC@edenpr.org. Please include multiple emergency contacts when registering.

Need financial assistance for afternoon camps?

What if my child is not referred - can they still attend camps at EPIC?

All students are welcome to attend EPIC. If you are not a referred student there is a fee attached to each camp. We offer financial assistance to families who qualify.



How Does the Targeted Services Registration Work?

1. Receive referral to Targeted Services from your classroom teacher.
2. Sign the Continuous Learning Plan provided by your classroom teacher.
3. Register for the camps of you and your student's choice at www.edenpr.org/EPIC, call 952-975-6940, or visit us at the Education Center.

*** When does Eagle Zone summer registration open?**

Summer programming opens online at 8:00 AM on February 7, 2020. March 1 is the last day to register with waived registration fee. Please see back cover for registration options.

*** What are the qualifying ages to enroll in the program?**

Children entering kindergarten next fall through children who will be completing sixth grade this spring are eligible to enroll in the program.

*** What are the dates that the program will be running?**

The program runs from June 15 – August 19, 2020.

*** How much will Eagle Zone cost in the summer?**

Full-day Eagle Zone Programming costs \$49/day per child for a standard rate. If the child is registered within seven days of the date of care, that is considered a "drop-in". The drop-in rate is \$55/day per child, and subject to availability. There are additional options for families who are also enrolling in EPIC. More information can be found on page 2. Registration fees are \$35/1 child, \$50/2 children, and \$60/3+ children.

*** Will snacks be provided?**

Eagle Zone will provide a morning and afternoon snack. Children who wish to have an additional snack are encouraged to bring a healthy option from home.

*** Do children need to bring a lunch?**

Children must bring a bag lunch and beverage, unless otherwise noted. There may be some field trips where a lunch is provided, but parents will be notified ahead of time when that is to happen. Lunches should be dry bag lunches, with no refrigeration requirements. If this changes, families will be notified by the site staff.
