In Person Kindergarten

Ask your in person kindergarten questions at a virtual Q&A on March 9 Will you have a student in kindergarten next year, or do you know someone who will? EHIS Online

We are currently registering Kindergarten, 1st and 2nd grade classes for EHSI Online for the 2022-23 school year. Our fully online program uses the same curriculum for our scholars as our in person program. No assessment is required to enter Kindergarten. New students entering 1st and 2nd grade will take an assessment in Spanish prior to admission. Current K - 4 Scholars

We are excited to share learning opportunities available to current K - 4 Eagle Heights Spanish Immersion scholars this summer through the EPIC Program! EPIC is Eden Prairie Schools' youth enrichment program, where scholars have the chance to explore their interests, strengthen their academic skills, and build relationships with friends.

Many summer EPIC classes are offered through the Targeted Services program. Targeted Services supports scholars as they strengthen their literacy, math, and social-emotional skills. Classes are taught by licensed Eden Prairie Teachers and align with district academic standards. These small-group, hands-on classes cover a wide variety of topics and are designed to maintain and strengthen skills in a fun, engaging and interactive experience.

Targeted Services classes are FREE for scholars who are referred to participate by their classroom teacher. Scholars who live within the district boundary can receive free busing to and from school. Classes will be held Monday-Thursday, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., from June 20 - August 11 (skipping the week of July 4).

In addition to Targeted Services classes, EPIC also offers a range of fee-based enrichment camps in the fields of art, sports, and STEM in the mornings and afternoons throughout the summer. Registration for all EPIC programming will open on Wednesday, March 16, at 8:00 AM at www.edenpr.org/EPIC.

Current 2nd Grade Students

Current 2nd grade students are encouraged to sign up for EHSI Summer Academy. EHSI teachers will guide students through an extension of Collaborative Literacy, the district's K-2 literacy curriculum, to develop the building blocks of literacy in English. Through exciting activities and individualized instruction, students will begin the bridging process between Spanish and English to ensure a smooth start in 3rd grade. Scholars recommended for Targeted Services who are entering 6th grade in Fall 2022 will have the opportunity to participate in classes focusing on English and Math skills, taught by Central Middle School teachers.
