Please follow these easy steps to schedule your scholar's conference.


- 1. Log-in to https://pickatime.com/ehsi/client?event=369430 or follow the link for conference scheduling on the Eden Prairie Website (edenpr.org).
- 2. The first page is "Welcome to the Online Scheduler." Enter your email address and click on "log-in / create an account." Your email address will be your login ID. Your password is your scholar's ID number. (If you do not remember your scholar's ID number, you can find it on the parent portal on our school's website edenpr.org and choose LOGIN from the top left menu.)
- 3. You will see your scholar's teacher's schedule. The names of the teachers are color coded to correspond to his / her schedule. Once you put in your times, your schedule will be available in printable format and will give you an option to have an email reminder sent to you.
- 4. If you have multiple households, only one parent/guardian will be able to schedule a conference time.

Conferences are held in the classroom unless a parent(s) have chosen Zoom preference. Homeroom conferences are scheduled in twenty-minute slots, specials and special education staff are scheduled in ten-minute slots. We look forward to seeing you at Parent/Teacher conferences!



Please be sure and place your order by 4:00 p.m. Monday, February 28. Once all orders are received we will provide additional information on delivery dates.


Ordering Class Photos

Would you like to help choose the interns who will be part of our school community for the 2022-23 school year? If so, SEF can use your help!

Intern interviews start in February, so we have an urgent need for an Interview Intern Coordinator (IIC). The time commitment is variable based on when Amity provides us with candidates, with as little as a few hours to up to ten hours per month. Historically, we conduct interviews from February through July. In this role, the IIC will partner closely with our SEF Intern Program Coordinator to:

- Receive candidate applications from Amity and

coordinate interview scheduling and logistics.

- Co-host the virtual video interview using a pre-set list of questions. Please note, the interviews are in English and Spanish.
- Review the candidate's interview responses, make recommendations on who to offer an intern position to, and inform Amity of the decision.

COVID Information



Please continue to report COVID cases to our EHSI COVID-19 Coordinator <u>Mitch Hegland</u>. In addition, scholars ages 5 and older are now eligible to be vaccinated for COVID-19.

Once scholars are fully vaccinated, they no longer need to quarantine if the following are true: (1) the COVID-19 exposure was at least 14 days after their vaccination series was fully completed, AND (2) they do not currently have any symptoms of
