

Third grade students will be helping organize a PROP Summer Food drive this year. During the summer when children do not receive free/reduced meals at school, PROP provides additional food to their families so kids can flourish at home. In 2021, 621 children from 305



unique families were served by Summer Food for Kids.

COVID Information



Please continue to report COVID cases to our EHSI COVID-19 Coordinator <u>Mitch Hegland</u>. In addition, scholars ages 5 and older are now eligible to be vaccinated for COVID-19.

Once scholars are fully vaccinated, they no longer need to quarantine if the following are true: (1) the COVID-19 exposure was at least 14 days after their vaccination series was fully completed, AND (2) they do not currently have any symptoms of
